The Merced Irrigation District (MID), located in California's agriculturally-rich Central Valley, is the leading provider of clean, affordable irrigation water for its 2,200 growers. The District is also the 20th largest public utility in the State, supplying electric service to commercial, industrial, and residential customers in Merced County. The District also owns Lake McClure and Lake McSwain and operates five recreation areas adjacent to these facilities. Lake McClure, on the Merced River, is formed by New Exchequer Dam, a rock filled dam with a reinforced concrete face. At the base of the dam is a hydroelectric generation facility with a capacity of 94.5 MW of power. MID is within two hours of San Francisco, Sacramento, Monterey, and Yosemite.

MID is seeking self-motivated and qualified individuals to work as Park-Aides at the Parks & Recreation Facilities located at Lakes McClure and Lake McSwain in Snelling, California. Under general supervision, Park-Aides will perform a variety of duties including customer service to visitors and assisting Park Ranger staff in their daily job functions, performing unskilled and semi-skilled labor related to the maintenance, and operation of all recreation areas and facilities. Assignments will include week-ends, holidays, and various shifts.
